Bring your festival glass back for free entry to subsequent sessions (subject to venue capacity limit) and then you can enjoy yourself all over again! Please note that almost all of the beers contain gluten and they may also contain other allergens but we are unaware of what they may be. If this is of concern to you don't imbibe.

PLEASE DO NOT DRINK AND DRIVE

As requested by the police and for your own safety, as well as that of others, please put your glass in the carrier bags supplied at the door before you leave. We suggest you don't wash your glass in a dishwasher as the logo may eventually degrade or wear off.

Smoking is not permitted inside this building at any time. The designated smoking zone is outside, accessed at the north end of the hall via the doors round the corner from the bar.

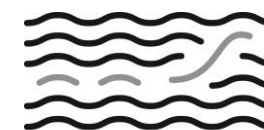
